We outlined the costs for a complete Donor Recipient Cycle for our patients that do not have insurance for donor care as well as our Combination Package and Guarantee Program.

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Payment is due upon coordination of your donor care. Cycle is complete upon your second pregnancy test. Upon pregnancy, we will bill your insurance carrier for the monitoring performed in our office. This service is covered under the major medical portion of most insurance policies.

Cryopreservation is not included in any of our cycle fees; therefore if cryopreservation of embryo(s) or Oocytes is performed by our laboratory you will be bill directly. A credit card will be place on file as a good faith gesture to settle any additional charges incurred.

Due to the time sensitive nature of First trimester immune treatment, we request a credit card authorization on file for our cycling patients so there will be no interruption or delay in patient care for ordering further testing, coordinating care or ordering medications upon a positive pregnancy test so they may transition into their First Trimester. Out of town patients must be seen in our office for an exam at week 6 and week 10 of their first trimester. Should you not transition to your second trimester, fee will include up to three attempts to reach your 12th week.
